Abstract	We examined how psychological safety fosters knowledge-sharing processes and enables team creative performance. Using a multi-respondent design, we tested our hypotheses using survey data collected from 73 patient-centred healthcare teams working in the field on rare diseases. The data were analysed using latent class regression analysis.
