Abstract	This report of the stock-taking exercise of the ILO's programme on measuring decent work was prepared by Ms Ana María García Femenía, an ILO evaluation consultant. The exercise, which was carried out from October 2013 to January 2014, was guided by the same principles as an independent evaluation and included a combination of desk research and interviews with ILO staff and constituents at ILO headquarters and in the field.
